

ORDINANCE NO. 488

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE TAX LEVY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING FEBRUARY 28, 2003.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING.

SECTION 1. That the amount of taxes to meet the expenditures of the Town of Mills, Wyoming, for the fiscal year beginning March 1, 2002, and ending February 28, 2003, shall be eight (8) mills, known as the general tax.
