

Ordinance No 49.

Concerning The Erection and Moving of Buildings or Dwellings Within The Town of Mills .

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MILLS?,
STATE OF WYOMING;

SECTION I. No person, associated or corporation shall, within the Town of Mills, erect or move any building or dwelling without first obtaining permit from the council of the Town of Mills. The application of such shall state the exact site to be occupied by the building or dwelling or from which and to which site the proposed building or dwelling is to be moved . together with a statement of the material , dimensions, general plan and cost for the erection of the proposed building or dwelling or in case the building or dwelling is already built and is to be moved , a description and general plan of the building shall be furnished together with the cost and general plan for moving the same . Also , a statement as to what street or part of streets of the Town of Mills the applicant desires to use in the erecting or moving of the said building or dwelling .

Section 2 : The council of the Town of Mills may refuse to grant a permit to an applicant where the application containing statements required above indicates that the building or dwelling would be unsanitary and dangerous to health or would be or is dangerous to property because of its inflammable character .

Section 3. Any person erecting or moving any building or dwelling in violation of the terms of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction shall be fined in any sum not exceeding \$100.00 with cost and shall be subject to imprisonment according to law until such fine is paid .
