

ORDINANCE \_\_\_\_\_

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING INTERFERENCE WITH  
THE RECEPTION OF RADIO BROADCAST SIGNALS.

Section I. The word "person" shall mean and include both the singular and plural, and shall mean and include any person individual, firm, corporation, partnership, co-partnership, association, club, society, or any other organization.

Section II. It shall be unlawful for any person to operate, or cause to be operated, in the city of Mills any device, appliance, equipment and/or apparatus which creates or causes high frequency oscillations, which can reasonably and feasibly be eliminated or prevented, and which interfere with the reception of radio broadcast signals, except as specified in Section # of this ordinance, provided:

That the radio receiver being interfered with complies with the requirements of the building inspector in regard to proper antenna and installation of radio receiver.

Section III. Equipment generation high frequency oscillations and generally prohibited by this ordinance may be lawfully used between the hours of ( 9 to 11 a.m.) ( 2 to 3 p.m.) (Midnight to 6 a. M.) . The provisions of this ordinance shall not apply to hospitals and medical equipment not practicably susceptible of filtration and used outside of the hours limited by the permissive exceptions of this section, where such use is necessary and cannot reasonably be concluded within the excepted periods.

Section IV. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall upon conviction be fined not more than twenty-five (25) dollars.
