## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 10.36.130 OF THE TOWN OF MILLS MUNICIPAL CODE PERTAINING TO PARKING TICKET TO CONSTITUTE NOTICE TO APPEAR -PROCEDURE ON FAILURE TO APPEAR

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING:

## **ORDINANCE 10.36.130**

PARKING TICKET TO CONSTITUTE NOTICE TO APPEAR – PROCEDURE ON FAILURE TO APPEAR.

It shall constitute notice to every person charged with violating this chapter if a member of the police department, or any police officer of the town or other person authorized by the Town Council affixes to or deposits in an automobile or vehicle found to be parked in violation of this chapter, a traffic violation ticket indicating thereon the location at which the violation occurred, the date upon which the same occurred, the license number of such vehicle, and notice of time and date the owner of such vehicle is required to appear at the municipal court of the town, to answer to the charge of such violation. The owner of any vehicle who fails to appear at court at the time fixed in any such notice shall be formally charged by complaint and warrant with violation of this chapter and shall be brought before the court to be dealt with in accordance with law. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after passage on three readings (and publication).


