

ORDINANCE NUMBER FIFTY-ONE

TOWN OF MILLS -- CORPORATE BOUNDARIES ESTABLISHED

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING:

SECTION 1.-----LOCATION, DESCRIPTION, NAME

LOCATION DESCRIBED. That the portion of the State of Wyoming, in the County of Natrona, which was originally platted and laid out as a townsite known as the MILLS ADDITION, together with such additions thereto as were subsequently made, which said territory includes approximately two hundred forty acres, comprising the south half of the north-west quarter, the north half of the south-west quarter, the north-west one fourth of the south-east quarter, and the south-west one fourth of the north-east quarter of section seven, in township thirty-three north of range seventy-nine, west of the sixth principal meridian; and which in the year A.D. 1921 was duly surveyed, mapped, advertised and incorporated according to law under the name of the Town of MILLS, and which is so recorded under number 79838, on page 572, in the Book of Deeds number 27, in the records of Natrona County, is hereby declared to be, and since the aforesaid year of 1921 to have been, a corporation by the name of the Town of MILLS.

SECTION 2.----- GENERAL CORPORATE POWERS

MAY SUE AND BE SUED. That the town of MILLS is, and is hereby declared to be, and since the aforesaid year of its incorporation to have been, a body corporate and politic, capable, through the agency of its council, of suing and being sued, invested with all the powers and attributes of a municipal corporation, which powers shall be exercised by the town council.

SECTION 3. -----That this ordinance is to take effect and be in full force after ten days from date.
