

ORDINANCE NO. 521

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NOS. 341, 283 AND 278,
CHAPTER 15.10, FIRE CODE

15.10.010 Adoption. Except as otherwise provided by this chapter, all of the ~~1982~~ **Uniform International Fire Code**, with all appendices and future editions is adopted as the code governing conditions hazardous to life and property from fire or explosion within the Town, and the same is adopted and incorporated as fully as if set out at length in this chapter. (Ord. 341, 1982: Ord. 283 §1 (part), 1979: Ord. 278 §1 (part), 1979).

15.10.020 Applicability. The ~~Uniform International~~ **Fire Code** applies to all new construction and **remodeling, maintenance, upkeep and repair of all** existing structures. However, ~~owners of existing structures have one year from November 7, 1979, in which to comply.~~ (Ord. 283 §1 (part), 1979; Ord. 278 §1(part), 1979).

15.10.030 Copy Filing. The authority for adoption of this code by the Town is derived from Section 15-1-120, Wyoming Statutes Annotated, 1977, and a sufficient number of copies, but not less than two copies of the code, shall be kept on file in the office of the Town Clerk for inspection by and use of the public **during normal business hours.** ~~and shall be marked with the words, "Town of Mills, Wyoming, Official Copy".~~ (Ord. 283 §2, 1979: Ord. 278 §2, 1979).

15.10.040 Board of Appeals. In order to hear any appeals from and to provide for reasonable interpretations of the provisions of this code, there shall be, and is created, a board of appeals consisting of the Town Council. The fire chief for the Town is an ex-officio member. **Any person wishing to appeal any action or requirement ordered by the fire chief or other designated code enforcement authority shall file a notice of appeal with the Town Clerk within twenty (20) days of the posting of such notice upon the property. The failure to timely request such appeal shall constitute a waiver of such remedy.** (Ord. 283 §4, 1979: Ord. 278 §4, 1979)


15.10.050 Violation – Each day a separate offense. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this code is guilty of a separate offense for each and every day, or portion thereof, during which any violation of any of the provisions of the code is committed, continued or permitted, **and upon conviction thereof may be punished as provided in 1.01.115 of this Code.** (Ord. 283 §3, 1979: Ord. 278 §3, 1978).


PASSED on 2nd reading the 5th day of October, 2005.

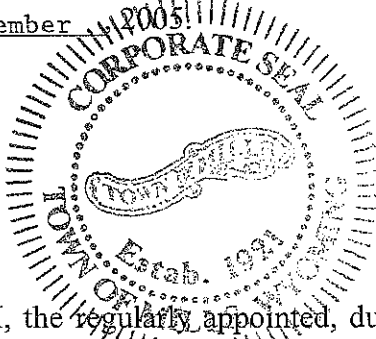
