AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 130 PERTAINING TO
DRIVER'S LICENSES IN THE TOWN OF MILLS

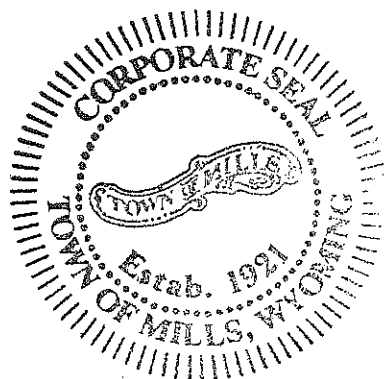
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING, THAT CHAPTER 10.48 OF THE MILLS MUNICIPAL
CODE BE AND HEREBY IS AMENDED TO PROVIDE AS FOLLOWS:

10.48.010 State Driver's License required: It is unlawful for any person to drive a motor
vehicle upon streets of this town unless the person has **in his possession** a valid operator's license
issued or recognized by the State of Wyoming **for the type and class of vehicle being operated** if
~~the operator's license is required of the person under the laws of the state. or chauffeur's license if~~
~~a chauffeur's license is required.~~ (Ord. 130 § 69, 1962).



PASSED on 2nd reading the 7th day of December, 2005.


PASSED, APPROVED, AND ADOPTED on the 3rd and final reading on the 4th
day of January, 2006.






