

ORDINANCE NUMBER FIFTY-TWO B

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND RE-ENACT SUBSECTION THREE OF SECTION ONE, SUBSECTION EIGHT OF SECTION FOUR, AND SUBSECTION THREE OF SECTION THIRTEEN OF ORDINANCE NUMBER FIFTY-TWO, RELATING TO DUTIES, POWERS, AUTHORITY AND RENUMERATION OF ALL MUNICIPAL OFFICERS OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING; WHICH SUBSECTIONS RELATE, RESPECTIVELY, TO RENUMERATION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCILMEN, TO THE PERIOD OF TIME DURING WHICH THE TOWN CLERK SHALL RECEIVE FILINGS OF CANDIDATES FOR ELECTION TO TOWN OFFICES, AND TO THE SALARIES OF JUDGES AND CLERKS OF ELECTIONS AND OF CONSTABLES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING:

SECTION 1.-- THAT SUBSECTION THREE OF SECTION ONE OF ORDINANCE NUMBER FIFTY-TWO, BE AMENDED AND RE-ENACTED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE - SUBSECTION 3.-- RENUMERATION OF OFFICIALS. That the salaries of all appointed officers of the town of Mills shall be as specifically provided by ordinance; and that, unless and until otherwise established by ordinance, the Mayor and Councilmen shall each be entitled to receive water from the municipal water system without charge, up to and including the amount per month specified by ordinance as the minimum amount for which charges are made. Provided that all water in excess of the said legally stipulated minimum quantities, received by the Mayor or by any Councilman in any month, shall be charged for at the same rate as that paid by any other consumer of water from the said municipal system. Provided that in addition to the water allowance herein established, the Mayor shall be ~~entitled~~ paid the sum of Six (\$6.00) dollars for each Council meeting attended by him, and that each Councilman shall be paid the sum of Four (\$4.00) dollars for each regular meeting of the Town Council attended by each such Councilman; all such sums to be audited and paid out of the general fund of the Town, upon a monthly basis, in the same manner as that in which other claims against the Town are paid; such payments to begin ~~with~~ at the time of the beginning of the official term of ~~each~~ the Mayor and of each Councilman who succeeds ^{any of} those officials presently in office ^{any of} in those positions. And that the remuneration of no elected officer of the town of Mills shall be either increased or diminished during the term of office for which said officer was elected.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND RE-ENACT SUBSECTION THREE OF SECTION ONE, SUBSECTION EIGHT OF SECTION FOUR, AND SUBSECTION THREE OF SECTION THIRTEEN OF ORDINANCE NUMBER FIFTY-TWO, RELATING TO DUTIES, POWERS, ETC. * - - - -

SECTION 2.-- THAT SUBSECTION EIGHT OF SECTION FOUR OF ORDINANCE NUMBER FIFTY-TWO, BE AMENDED TO THE FOLLOWING EXTENT:

That subsection eight of section ~~XXXX~~ four of Ordinance Number Fifty-two is hereby amended to the extent that section 36-515 of the Revised Statutes of the State of Wyoming (1931) as carried forward into the Wyoming Compiled Statutes of 1945 (Section 31-710) was amended in Chapter 38 of the Session Laws of Wyoming of 1947; such amendment providing for the receiving by the Town Clerk of certificates of nomination to town offices, at any time not more than thirty nor less than ten days before election.

SECTION 3.-- THAT SUBSECTION THREE OF SECTION THIRTEEN OF ORDINANCE NUMBER FIFTY-TWO BE AMENDED AND RE-ENACTED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION THIRTEEN - SUBSECTION 3.-- RENUMERATION, JUDGES, CLERKS, CONSTABLES.

That the Judges, Clerks and the Constables of Elections shall receive a salary of Six dollars (\$6.00) each for each full day of their services attending elections; provided that ten hours shall constitute one such day and that additional hours served shall be paid for at the same pro-rated rate; provided further that all of the aforesaid Election Officials shall be entitled, on Election day, to receive two meals each; all such salaries as herein provided and all costs of meals as aforesaid, to be paid out of the general fund of the Town.

SECTION 4.-- THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BECOME IN FORCE AFTER ITS BEING POSTED UP FOR A PERIOD OF TEN DAYS , AS REQUIRED BY LAW.
