

ORDINANCE 530

AN ORDINANCE REZONING THE SOUTH 80 FEET OF TRACT "A", LEWIS ADDITION TO THE TOWN MILLS, NATRONA COUNTY, WYOMING

WHEREAS the owner of property being the south 80 feet of Tract "A", Lewis Addition has proposed to rezone the property from Established Industrial to Established Residential, and has submitted a plat which creates two new residential lots in the area, to be known as Alaska Addition; and

WHEREAS, the Town has held public hearings on the rezoning and the Zoning Board Recommends approval of the rezoning; and

WHEREAS the Council has determined the zone change is in the interest of the town and the owner

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING:

The Town of Mills hereby zones the annexing property in the following manner under Mills Zoning Ordinance 312:

All lots shall be zoned Established Residential.

PASSED on 2nd reading the 6 day of Sept., 2006.

PASSED, APPROVED, AND ADOPTED on the 3rd and final reading on the 4 day of Oct, 2006.
