ORDINANCE 542

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 18.04.030 OF THE MILLS ZONING ORDINANCE 312, TOWN OF MILLS, NATRONA COUNTY, WYOMING TO ADD A DEFINITION OF RECREATIONAL VEHICLE

WHEREAS the Town of Mills, pursuant to Wyoming Statute 15-1-501 through 15-1-601, had adopted zoning ordinances within the Town of Mills; and

WHEREAS the Town has determined the need to add a definition for Recreational Vehicles to the Town Zoning Ordinance 312;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING AMENDS MILLS ZONING ORDINANCE 312 18.04.030 AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Recreational Vehicle:</u> A vehicular-type unit designed as temporary living quarters for recreational, camping, living, or travel use, which either has its own motive power or is mounted on or drawn by another vehicle. Use of recreational vehicles as permanent dwellings or as a primary residence on a lot is prohibited.
