

ORDINANCE NUMBER FIFTY- SEVEN

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE MUNICIPAL TAXATION FOR THE YEAR OF 1944.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MILLS: WYOMING.

SECTION I. TAX SET IN ACCORDANCE WITH ESTABLISHED PRECEDENT AND WITH WYOMING STATE LAW. That, in Accordance the Precedent Established by Ordinance Number Twenty-Three, of the Ordinances for the Town of MILLS, and in Compliance with Section II5-1001 of the Wyoming Revised Statutes and in Order to Meet the Current Expende of the Town, there shall be Levied upon all Property, Real, Personal, and Mixed, within the Town of MILLS, a General Tax (for the year of 1944) of Eight (8) Mills on Each Dollar of Assessed Valuation; and the Town Clerk is Hereby Authorized and Instructed to Certify to the County Clerk of Natrona County that the Above Specified Assessment is Regular and Correct and in Accordance with the Wishes of the Town Council.

SECTION 2. --- ORDINANCE TO TAKE EFFECT AFTER TEN DAYS. That this Ordinance shall Take Effect and be in Force after Ten Days from Date.
