

ORDINANCE NO. 573

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO 571  
PERTAINING TO THE BUDGET OF THE TOWN OF MILLS. WYOMING  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING Ordinance No. 571 pertaining to the budget of the Town of Mills, Wyoming contained deficiencies with respect to the budget of the Mills Police Department, and The Town Engineer, Worthington, Lenhart & Carpenter, Engineering, Surveying & Planning and WHEREAS the budget should immediately be amended to provide additional funds for these departments to serve the public health, safety and welfare.

WHEREAS the Town has surplus funds available to provide for the budget amendments herein.

WHEREAS the budget should immediately be amended to provide additional funds for these departments to serve the public health, safety and welfare.

WHEREAS the funds originally budgeted for these department expenditures is insufficient to meet the needs of said departments to serve the public health, safety and welfare, and

WHEREAS the funding provided by this ordinance is needed immediately to continue serving the public health, safety and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING:

SECTION 1:

Ordinance No. 571 pertaining to the Budget of the Town of Mills, Wyoming is hereby amended to provide additional funding to the Town of Mills Police Department in the amount of \$7,000.00.

SECTION 2:

Ordinance No. 571 pertaining to the Budget of the Town of Mills, Wyoming is hereby amended to provide additional funding to Worthington, Lenhart & Carpenter, Engineering, Surveying and Planning in the amount of \$ 44,000.00 for Engineering Services for the Town of Mills, Wyoming.

SECTION 3:

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING that the funding source for the budget increases authorized herein shall be from excess funds from the Town of Mills budget identified below:

SECTION 4:

Pursuant to W.S. §15-1-115(c) for an emergency Ordinance, the requirements relating to public readings and the ten (10) day elapse between introduction and passage may be suspended by the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the qualified members of the governing body; and, pursuant to W.S. §15-1-115(d), the passage of an emergency Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the qualified members of the governing body.

SECTION 5:

Pursuant to W.S. §15-1-105(a)(iii), an emergency Ordinance means an Ordinance operating for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety or welfare, in which the emergency is defined.

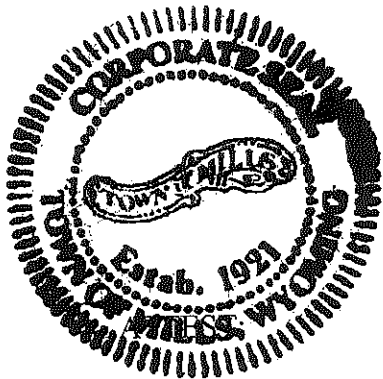
SECTION 6:
