ORDINANCE NO. <u>587</u>

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SEWER AND SANITATION RATES FOR THE TOWN OF MILLS, NATRONA COUNTY, WYOMING.

WHEREAS increased costs to the Town of Mills have created a situation which significantly increased the Town's sewer and sanitation costs; and

WHEREAS the Town considers it to be a significant improvement of service to provide owners and tenants with a pass to use the Casper Bale Fill through the Mills water bill; and

WHEREAS this ordinance amends ORDINANCE 566; and

WHEREAS the Town of Mills strives to ensure the health and safety of the citizens of Mills, the Town must adopt the new sewer and sanitation rate increases to ensure a clean and safe living environment to the growing needs of the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING that the following rates for sewer and sanitation will be as follows:

SECTION 1 ANNEXED RESIDENTIAL SEWER AND SANITATION RATES:

Sewer rates for the Town's residential customers are hereby established to be \$39.60. Sanitation rates for the Town's residential customers are hereby established to be \$39.60 for one 95 gallon container per quarter emptied once per week.

SECTION 2 ANNEXED COMMERCIAL SEWER AND SANITATION RATES:
Sewer rates for the Town's commercial customers are hereby established to be \$46.80 per quarter for up to 6,000 gallons and a charge of \$.30 per 1,000 over the minimum 6,000 gallons. Sanitation rates for the Town's commercial customers are hereby established to be \$30.60 for one 95 gallon container per quarter emptied once per week: \$90.00 for one

be \$39.60 for one 95 gallon container per quarter emptied once per week; \$90.00 for one 300 gallon container per quarter emptied once per week; and \$90.00 for a 3 yard bin per quarter emptied once per week.

SECTION 3 EXTRA-TERRITORIAL RESIDENTIAL SEWER RATES:

Sewer rates for residential properties outside the town limits are hereby established to be \$59.40 per quarter.

SECTION 4 EXTRA-TERRITORIAL COMMERCIAL SEWER RATES:

Sewer rates for commercial properties outside the town limits are hereby established to be \$70.20 per quarter for up to 6,000 gallons and a charge of \$.46 per 1,000 over the minimum 6,000 gallons.

SECTION 5 USE OF THE CASPER BALE FILL:

Each quarterly billing will contain three punches to be used by the payer of the bill at the Casper Bale Fill. These punches will allow the payer to haul trash and garbage to the Casper Bale Fill and dispose of it there with no additional charge. This program is subject to the rules and regulations of the Casper Bale Fill concerning oversized loads, hazardous materials and other requirements.

SECTION 6 EFFECTIVE DATE:

The sewer and sanitation rates hereby listed above shall become effective October 1, 2012.
