

ORDINANCE NO. 602

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHINE THE ANIMAL LIMITS FOR THE TOWN OF MILLS, NATRONA COUNTY WYOMING.

WHEREAS, the Town of Mills has the authority to regulate the keeping of domestic animals: and,

WHEREAS, the Town of Mills has the authority to regulate animals which are dangerous to persons or property: and,

WHEREAS, the Town of Mills has determined that it is in the interest of the public health, safety and welfare to address animal matters: and,

WHEREAS, the Town of Mills will limit the number of dogs or cats that reside at a town property to three (3) at any one time: and

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF MILLS, WYOMING Ordinance 602 is hereby adopted:

Except for duly authorized kennels, catteries, and veterinary clinics, it is unlawful for any person to own, keep or harbor upon any property within the Town more than three (3) dogs and/or cats over the age of six months.

Any person violating this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed \$ 750.00 (seven-hundred-fifty) dollars. Every day such violation continues shall constitute a separate offense.
