

ORDINANCE NO. 608

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 13.04.020 PERTAINING TO FEES FOR TURNING ON WATER - - COMPLIANCE WITH REGULATIONS WITHIN THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING.

WHEREAS The Town Of Mills wishes to limit the financial losses resulting from customers failure to pay utility bills, and:

WHEREAS, the resulting losses to the Town of Mills due to non payment of utility bills causes an increase in operating costs which should be eliminated and reduced to the fullest extent possible.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING THAT ORDINANCE 13.04.020 IS HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

13.04.020 Fee for turning on water - - Compliance with regulations.

Any person wishing to use water from the Mills municipal water system shall request that the Town water department office turn the water into the lines providing the water service **at least three working days prior to the start of service.** ~~for which the person shall pay a five-dollar fee to the town clerk.~~

Applications for utility service shall be submitted to the town clerk and must contain the name of applicant, physical address, mailing address, social security number, day and night time telephone number, employer and requested date of service. All applications shall be accompanied by a deposit in an amount determined by resolution by the Town Council. No deposit will be returned if any outstanding balance remains owed. The town may release the deposit to the applicant upon request of the applicant after having demonstrated good credit by timely payment of all utility bills for a period of two years.

The water user shall thereafter pay to the town the regular water use fees, as are hereinafter established, and shall abide by all the rules and regulations established by the town concerning the dispensation of water from the municipal water system **along with the use of the town sanitary sewer systems.**

In the event any water service shall be discontinued or disconnected due to nonpayment of water use fees or other violations of any rules and regulations provided in this chapter, such person shall not be eligible to receive continued water service until such person shall pay to the town clerk a twenty-five-dollar fee for reinstatement of the water service. Upon a second and subsequent discontinuation or disconnection, such person shall pay a fifty dollar fee for reinstatement of the water service.

The mayor, with the consent of the town council, may waive such reinstatement fees upon a showing of good and sufficient just cause.

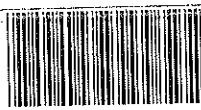
Effective Date.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten (10) days following its passage and approval on third and final reading.

Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances.

All existing Ordinances or parts of Ordinances of the Town of Mills, Wyoming are hereby amended or repealed insofar as they may be inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance.

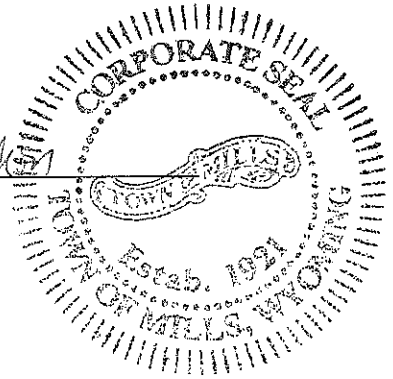
