## ORDINANCE NUMBER SIXTY A

AMENDING AND RE-ENACTING SECTION ONE OF ORDINANCE NUMBER SIXTY, WHICH IS AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING TRAFFIC REGULATIONS FOR THE TOWN OF MILLS, WHICH SECTION ONE RELATES TO THE APPLICATION OF CERTAIN WORDS AND EXPRESSIONS WITHIN THE SAID ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MILLS:

SECTION 1. -- THAT SECTION ONE OF ORDINANCE NUMBER SIXTY BE AMENDED AND RE-ENACTED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. TO APPLY TO TOWN OF MILLS ONLY, CERTAIN WORDS DEFINED. That all the regulations contained in this ordinance shall be construed as applying to the town of Mills only; that all officers mentioned herein shall be understood to be officers of the said Town; that all streets, alleys, highways, or other locations shall, unless otherwise specified, be understood to be the streets, alleys, highways or other locations of the town of Mills; and that the word "highway" as employed herein shall mean any thoroughfare; and no reference herein contained shall be construed otherwise than as indicated in this section unless the context clearly indicates a different meaning.

SECTION 2. -- THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BECOME IN FORCE AFTER ITS BEING POSTED UP FOR A PERIOD OF TEN DAYS AS REQUIRED BY LAW.
