ORDINANCE NUMBER SIXTY-ONE

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE AMOUNT OF THE MUNICIPAL TAX FOR THE YEAR OF 1945

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MILLS . WYOMING:

SECTION I. --- TAX SET IN ACCORDANCE WITH ESTABLISHED PRECEDENT AND WITH WYOMING STATE LAW. That, in accordance with the Precedent Established by the Ordinances of the town of MILLS, and in compliance with Section II5-IOOI of the Revised Statutes of the State of Wyoming (1931), and in order to Meet the Current Expenses of the town of MILLS, there shallnbe Levied upon All Property, Real, Personal, and Mixed, within the Corporate Limits of the Town, Excluding only that Property which is by Wyoming Law Exempt from Taxation, a General Tax for the year of 1945 of Eight (8) Mills on Each Dollar of Assessed Valuation: and the Town Clerk is Hereby Authorized, and it is Hereby made his Duty to Certify to the Clerk of Natrona County that the Above Specified Assessment is Legal and Correct and in accordance with the Wishes of the town Council of the town of MILLS.

SECTION 2. ----ORDINANCE TO TAKE EFFECT AFTER TEN DAYS FROM DATE. That this Ordinance shall take Effect and be in force after Ten Days from Date.
