ORDINANCE NO. 61/

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 10.36.110 PERTAINING TO OVERSIZE AND OVERWEIGHT VEHICLES WITHIN THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING.

WHEREAS, the operation of oversize and overweight vehicles on streets and roadways within the Town can cause significant damage to the streets and roadways, and;

WHEREAS, W.S. §15-1-103 (xi) authorizes the Town to take all necessary action to modify, repair, maintain and regulate the use of streets within the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING THAT ORDINANCE 10.36.110 IS HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

10.36.110 Oversize and overweight vehicles.

No person shall **drive**, **operate**, stop, stand, **store** or park any vehicle which weight, together with its load, is in excess of sixteen thousand pounds, or any vehicle in excess of eight feet in width, upon the streets of the town, excluding designated through streets, except for the purpose of actual loading or unloading of such vehicle or its load.

The term "vehicle" as used in this Ordinance shall include trucks and trailers designed, used or maintained for the transportation of property including any trailer which is not attached to a truck. (Ord. 461 (part) 1999).

Effective Date.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten (10) days following its passage and approval on third and final reading.

Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances.

All existing Ordinances or parts of Ordinances of the Town of Mills, Wyoming are hereby amended or repealed insofar as they may be inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance.
