ORDINANCE NUMBER SIXTY-SEVEN

AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER SIXTY-SEVEN, WHICH IS AN ORDINANCE LAYING A LICENSE TAX UPON THE BUSINESS OF PUBLIC UTILITY COMPANIES AND OTHERS MAINTAINING, OPERATING AND/OR CARRYING ON CERTAIN DESIGNATED BUSINESSES WITHIN THE TOWN OF HILLS, PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION OF AND FOR THE GRANTING OF FRANCHISES AND LICENSES TO SUCH UTILITY COMPANIES AND OTHER BUSINESS OPERATORS AND SETTING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF THE TERMS THEREOF;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HILLS, WYOMING:

SECTION ONE -- AMENDING AND RE-ENACTING SECTIONS SEVEN AND TEN OF ORDINANCE NUMBER SIXTY-SEVEN:

That Ordinance Number Sixty-seven, which ordinance is entitled: "An Ordinance Laying a License Tax, for the Purpose of Raising Revenue, upon the Business of all Public Utilities (as Defined in the Statutes of the State of Wyoming, Sec. 94-101) Operating Within the Town of Hills, and upon the Business of all Persons Maintaining, Operating and/or Carrying On any Business whatsoever, Excepting only Retail Liquor Businesses, Within said Town: Providing for the Regulation of and for the Granting of Franchises and Licenses to such Utilities and the Operators of such Businesses; Setting a Penalty for Violators hereunder; Repealing Ordinances Number Six, Eight, Nine, Fourteen, Nineteen, Twenty-two, Twenty-four, Thirty-eight, Thirty-nine, Forty-one, Forty-five-A, and Forty-seven, and all other Ordinances and Parts of Ordinances in Conflict with the Provisions herein Contained," shall be amended to the extent that Sections Seven and Ten of the aforesaid Ordinance Number Sixty-Seven, shall be and are hereby repealed, amended and re-enacted to hereafter read as follows, to-wit:

SECTION 7.--TAX FOR OMBIBUS AND TAXICAL COMPANIES. That all persons who shall operate within the town of Hills any omnibus or taxi-cab service or any vehicle or vehicles by means of which persons are transported for charge or hire, or who shall offer such service to the public, shall pay to the said town of Hills an annual tax in the sum hereinafter provided as follows, to-wit: taxicab companies Fifteen (\$15.00) dollars; omnibus companies, Fifteen dollars (\$15.00)!

SECTION 10.--ESTABLISHING FEES FOR LICENSES ISSUED HEREUNDER. That fees for licenses of all businesses within the town of Hills not hereinbefore or otherwise provided by Ordinance, shall be as herein

SECTION 10. continued---specified and established as follows, to-wit:

Grocery business (including dispensation of meats, dairy products, tobacco and tobacco products, soft drinks and other merchandise commonly offered for sale at such establishments) ten dollars; Soft drink and lunch carb service dispensary, ten dollars; Public dining room, ten dollars; Lunch room, ten dollars; Trucking yard, twenty-five dollars; Junk yard, twenty-five dollars; Used furniture store, ten dollars; Used car lot, ten dollars; Machine shop, twenty-five dollars; Drilling contractors ~~xxxxxxxxxx~~ (transportation department) fifteen dollars; Automobile repair shop, ten dollars; Gasoline filling station or service station, five dollars; Sales pavilion (including sale of livestock, used furniture, farm implements, cars and other merchandise, and operating of lunch counter, barn dance, stock show and other enterprises and/or exhibitions commonly a part of sales pavilion operation) twenty dollars; Beauty parlor, ten dollars; Barber shop, ten dollars; Hotel or rooming house (offering more than five rooms for rent) ten dollars; Apartment house (offering three or more apartments for rent) ten dollars; Pool hall, fifteen dollars; (in addition to the regular license fee for such establishments and for each table therein, as now established by state law); Dance hall, ten dollars; Skating rink, fifteen dollars; motion picture theater, twenty-five dollars; Trailer house (after first ten days of occupancy of any site within town limits) one dollar per month; Peddlers of farm produce (travelling within Natrona County and selling or delivering for sale wares actually produced within the said area) one dollar; Peddlers generally, two dollars per day; Solicitors (not resident within Natrona County nor representing firms within the said area) five dollars per day; Milk distributing route (not wholesale) ten dollars; Monument or tombstone plant, fifteen dollars; Laundry, advertising and actually operating business, ten dollars; Laundry and/or Dry cleaning route, soliciting business for Casper headquarters, ten dollars; Construction company, headquarters, branch office or storage lot, ten dollars; Sewage disposal contractors, five dollars per day; other businesses, not listed herein but subject to license as provided by the

SECTION TEN (Continued) terms thereof, ten dollars.

SECTION 2.--REMAINDER OF ORDINANCE NUMBER SIXTY-SEVEN TO REMAIN UNALTERED. That except as provided in the foregoing section, Ordinance number Sixty-seven shall remain unaltered and in force as a legal Ordinance of the town of Mills.

SECTION 3/--ORDINANCE NOT TO BE INVALIDATED BY ANY PART DECLARED UNCONSTITUTIONAL. That if any Section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason, declared unconstitutional or in violation of the statutes of the state of Wyoming, such decision shall not affect the remaining portion of this Ordinance, which shall continue in force the same as though no deletion had been made.

SECTION 4.--THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BE IN FORCE AFTER ITS BEING POSTED FOR A PERIOD OF TEN DAYS AS REQUIRED BY LAW.
