

ORDINANCE NUMBER SEVEN.

MOTOR VEHICLES--SPEED.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Town Council of the Town of Mills, State of Wyoming;

Sec.1. That no person shall operate a motor vehicle on any street or alley within the limits of said Town at a greater speed than twenty miles per hour, and that at all intersection of streets or alleys, such speed shall be reduced and all persons so operating motor cars or motor vehicles shall have due regard for the condition of the traffic and shall not operate said motor vehicles at a rate of speed so as to endanger the life or limb of any person, and any person violating the terms of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be fined in a sum not less than five dollars nor more than twenty-five dollars for each and every offense.

Provided further that the provisions of this section shall not apply to physicians or surgeons, or police or fire vehicles, or ambulances when answering emergency calls demanding excessive speed.
