

ORDINANCE NO. 706

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE 9.24.040

In lieu of the provision set forth in paragraph 9.24.030 above the commute, upon providing ten days' notice, may enter or cause to be entered any property where weeds or vegetation constitute a possible health or safety hazard for the purpose of addressing the same. All costs for the same shall be assessed to the property owner.

After receiving said notice the property owner may object to such entry by filing a notice of objection with the Town Of Mills. In such instance said property owner shall be afforded a hearing no later than ten day thereafter.

PASSED, APPROVED, AND ADOPTED on the 1<sup>st</sup> Reading as an emergency ordinance this 12<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2017.
