

ORDINANCE NUMBER SEVENTY-THREE

THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE FOR THE NEXT FISCAL YEAR  
(Beginning May 1, 1947 and Ending April 30, 1948)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING:

SECTION 1. -- UNEXPENDED MONEYS TO REVERT TO GENERAL FUND. That all moneys hereby appropriated shall, upon completion of the project for which the appropriation is made, or upon expiration of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made, revert to the general fund of the town and shall be subject to subsequent appropriation.

SECTION 2. --- APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS. That there is hereby appropriated from the general fund of the town of Mills, for the purpose of defraying the municipal expenses during the fiscal year beginning May 1, 1947, and ending April 30, 1948, the following sums, to-wit:
