## ORDINANCE NUMBER SEVENTY-SIX

GRANTING A NON-EXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE TO JOHNNY SCHILPZAND, HIS SUCCESSORS AND ABSIGNS, TO OPERATE A PUBLIC BUS SERVICE TO BE KNOWN AS THE MILLS EQUINTAIN VIEW DUS LINE, WITH LOADING STOPS AT SUCH POINTS WITHIN THE TOWN OF MILLS AS MAY BE HEREAFTER AGREED UPON? TO USE SUCH LOADING STOPS FOR THE COLLECTION OF PASSENCERS, TO CHARGE EACH SUCH PASSENCER A PARE OF FIFTEEN CENTS OR SUCH OTHER PARE AS MAY BE LATER AGREED UPON BETWEEN THE SAID JOHNEY SCHILPZAND AND THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MILLS: REQUIRING LATER THAN THE FIRST DAY OF JULY, 1948. TO OPERATE AS HEREIN DESCRIBED, NOT LATER THAN THE FIRST DAY OF JULY, 1948. TO OPERATE LEAST ONE BUS EACH HOUR? ON THE HOUR? BETWEEN THE TOWN OF MILLS AND THE CITY OF CABPER, EVERY DAY BETWEEN THE HOURS OF SIX A/M., AND TWELVE MIDNINGT, INCLUSIVELY, BUS LINE AND THE HOURS OF PROVIDED BY SPECIAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE SAID OF SUCH LINE SHALL, WHILE OPERATING WITHIN THE TOWN OF MILLS? OR CARRY-ING PASSENCERS TO OR FROM THE SAID TOWN, BE DRIVEN BY ANY OTHER THAN A SOURCE AND ADEQUATE INSURANCE? FOR THE PROTECTION OF PASSENCERS THEREOF, AS REQUIRED BY STATE LAW: AND SHALL BE SUPJECT TO REVOCATION BY THE TOWN OF MILLS? PRANCHISE SHALL BE REQUIRED BY ORDINANCE, AND SHALL BE SUPJECT TO REVOCATION BY THE TOWN OF MILLS. FOR ANY VIO ATION OF ANY TRAFFIC ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF MILLS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING:

SMCTION 1.—NON-EXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE HERBEY GRANTED/ That a non-exclusive franchise is hereby granted to Johnny Schilpzand, his successors and assigns, to operate a public bus services to be known as the Mills Mountain View Bus Line, within the town of Mills and over the streets and intersections thereof, with such loading stops within the said town as may be agreed upon with, and satisfactory to, the Town Council thereof; to use such loading stops for the collection of and/or discharge of passengers; to begin such operation the first day of July.

1948, and to continue the same for a period of one year, subject only to the provision that compliance with the requirements contained in subsequent sections of this Ordinance, shall be necessary to the continuation of this franchise, as provided in a subsequent section thereof.

SECTION 2.—HOURS OF OPERATION, FARLS TO BE CHARGED. That unless and until otherwise provided by special agreement by and between the said Johnny Schilpzand and the Town Council of the town of Mills, the bus line herein n named shall be required to operate at least one bus every hour, upon the hour, between six a.m., and twelve midnight, inclusively, every day; and the fare to be charged each passenger for the trip from Mills to Casper, or from Casper to Mills, shall be fifteen cents.

GRANTING A FRANCHISE TO MOHNNY SCHILPZAND TO OPERATE A PUBLIC BUS SERVICE, ETC. --

SECTION 3.--REQUIRING AMEQUATE INSURANCE COVERAGE, SOBER DRIVERS. That, for the protection of passengers of the said bus line, all buses thereof operating under the franchise as herein granted, shall be covered by adequate and suitable insurance, as required by the laws of the state of Wyoming; and no such bus so operating, shall while carrying passengers to or from the town of Mills, or operating within the said town, be operated by any other than a sober and desponsible person.

That upon the expiration of this franchise, it shall be renewable by the said Johnny Schilpzand, his successors and assigns, for a period of one year, with all priveleges and rights as herein contained, extended for that period, upon the filing of a written application with the Town Clerk and payment of the regular fee as required in Ordinance Number Sixtyseven, provided the Town Council shall at that time agree to made such renewal and shall enter such decision upon their Journal.

SECTION 5. -- FRANCHISE SUBJECT TO REVOCATION/ That the franchise hereby granted shall be subject to revocation by the Town Council, upon proof certainly established of any violation of any of the provisions of this Ordinance or of any traffic ordinance of the town of Mills, by the bus line hereby enfranchised.

SECTION 6. -- THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BECOME IN FORCE, FOLLOWING ITS POSTING FOR A PERIOD OF TEN DAYS IN THREE PUBLIC PLACES WITHIN THE TOWN OF MILLS, &S REQUIRED BY LAW!
