

ORDINANCE NUMBER SEVENTY-EIGHT A

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND RE-ENACT SECTION THREE OF ORDINANCE NUMBER SEVENTY-EIGHT, WHICH IS AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING AND REGULATION OF TRAILER COACH PARKS AND CABIN CAMPS WITHIN THE TOWN OF MILLS, WHICH SECTION THREE ESTABLISHES A LICENSE FEE FOR OPERATION OF SUCH TRAILER COACH PARKS AND CABIN CAMPS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MILLS:

SECTION 1.-- THAT SECTION THREE OF ORDINANCE NUMBER SEVENTY-EIGHT BE AMENDED AND RE-ENACTED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 3.-- LICENSE FEE. That the license fee for each trailer coach park shall be Fifty dollars for the first ten trailer coach lots or fraction thereof, and five dollars per annum for each additional coach lot in excess of ten; provided that Section Ten of Ordinance Number Sixty-seven, insofar as the said section does relate to a fee established for parking of trailer houses within the town of Mills, shall be disregarded and shall not govern or affect trailer houses or trailer coaches occupying regularly established trailer coach lots within any Trailer Coach Park operated in accordance with law as established in the said Ordinance Number ~~Sixty-seven~~ Seventy-eight.

SECTION 2.-- THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BECOME IN FORCE AFTER ITS BEING POSTED UP FOR A PERIOD OF TEN DAYS, AS REQUIRED BY LAW.
