ORDINANCE NUMBER EIGHT. POOL HALLS-LICENSE.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Town Council of the Town of Mills, State of Wyoming:

Sec.1. That any person who shall hereafter conduct a pool or billiard hall within the corporate limits of said Town, shall within 10 days after the passage of this ordinance obtain from the treasurer of the Town of Mills, a license to conduct said pool or billiard hall and that the license fee for such business shall be the sum of one hundred dollars per year, which may be paid quarterly. That said license shall be displayed in a conspicuous place in the room used for such business. Any person violating the terms of this ordinance or conducting a pool or billiard hall within the limits of said Town without first obtaining a license therefor, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined in a sum not less than twenty-five dollars nor more than two hundred dollars.

Sec. 2. Any person conducting a pool or billiard hall within the limits of said town shall display a sign in a conspicuous place in said building used for such business with the following language: "NO MINORS ALLOWED". No person conducting such place of business shall permit the same to be used for any other purpose or business, and any person conducting a pool hall who shall allow or permit minors, or person or persons under the age of 18 years to loiter or assemble in such place of business, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined in a sum not less than five dollars nor more than one hundred dollars for each and every such offense.
