

ORDINANCE NUMBER EIGHTY

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE AMOUNT OF THE MUNICIPAL TAX FOR THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING, FOR THE YEAR 1949.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING

SECTION 1.-- TAX SET IN ACCORDANCE WITH ESTABLISHED PRECEDENT AND WITH WYOMING STATE LAW.

That in accordance with precedent established by Ordinance of the Town Council of the town of Mills, and in compliance with Section 115-1001 of the revised statutes of the state of Wyoming (1931) and in order to meet the current expenses of the town of Mills, there shall be levied upon all property, real, personal, and mixed, within the corporate limits of the said town, excluding only that property which is by Wyoming law exempt from taxation, a general tax for the year of 1949, of eight (8) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation; and that the Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to certify to the County Clerk of Natrona County, Wyoming, that the above specified assessment is legal and correct and in accordance with the decision of the Town Council of the town of Mills.

SECTION 2. -- THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BE IN FORCE FROM AND AFTER ITS POSTING UP FOR A PERIOD OF TEN DAYS AS REQUIRED BY LAW.
