PROVIDING FOR THE VACATING AND CLOSING FOREVER TO PUBLIC USE, BY THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYONING, OF THAT PORTION OF THE STREET KNOWN AS RIVER DRIVE LYING BETWEEN THE POINTS AT FEICE THE SAID RIVER DRIVE INTERSECTE THIRD STREET AND FOURTH STREET, RESPECTIVELY, AND DECLARING THAT THIS VACATING ACTION SHALL NOT IN ANY MANNER AFFECT OR OBSTRUCT THE THOROUGHFARE KNOWN AS MORGAN AVENUE, AS THE SAID RIVER DRIVE, THIRD STREET, FOURTH STREET, AST MORGAN AVENUE ARE ESTABLISHED IN THE RECORDED PLAT OF THE TOWN OF MILLS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING:

SECTION 1. -- PORTION OF RIVER DRIVE TO BE VACATED. That the portion of River Drive, as the same is shown in the plat of the town of Mills recorded under number 79838, on page 572, in the book of deeds number 27, in the Natrona county records, that is:

That portion of River Drive enclosed by a boundary line beginning at a point at the northwesterly corner of Block 46 and running along the southwesterly boundary line of the said Block 46, in a southeasterly direction for a distance of 206.15 feet, to the southeasterly corner of the said block; thence southwesterly, following a straight course establishable by alignment with the boundary between Lots 13 and 14 in Block 44, for a distance of 41.23 feet to a point on the southwesterly boundary of the said River Drive; thence northwesterly along the said boundary of the said River Drive, on a line running parallel to the lot line 4% of Block 46, for a distance of 206.15 feet, to the point at which the said River Drive intersects Fourth street; thence northeasterly across River Drive and along the boundary of the said Fourth street, for a distance of 41.23 feet, to the point of beginning

be and the same is hereby vacated and forever closed to public use; provided that this action does not abridge or destroy any of the rights and privaleges of other proprietors in the said plat and does not affect any part or portion of Morgan avenue, nor of any public highway laid out according to law, other than as herein Specifically designated.

Section 2. -- DESIGNATION OF TRACT. That the portion of River Drive described in Section 1 of this Ordinance and by the said Section 1 of this Ordinance vacated, shall hereafter constitute Tract "O" in the NN + of the SE + of Section 7, Township 33 North, Range 79 West of the 6th Principle Meridian, so that tract "O" will consist of that portion of River Drive which lies between the intersections of the said River Drive with Fourth street and Morgan avenue, tespectively,
