ORDINANCE NUMBER EIGHTY-FOUR

PROVIDING FOR THE VACATING AND THE CLOSING FOREVER TO PUBLIC USE BY THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING, OR ANY OF THE RESIDNETS THEREOF, OF THAT PORTION OF RIVER DRIVE LYING BETWEEN THE INTERSECTIONS OF THE SAID RIVER DRIVE WITH THIRD AND FOURTH STREETS, RESPECTIVELY, AND EXTENDING INTO AND ACROSS THE AFORESAID THIRD STREET, AS THE SAID RIVER DRIVE AND THIRD AND FOURTH STREETS, RESPECTIVELY, ARE SHOWN ON THE RECORDED PLATS OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, MILLS ADDITION, AND ALL SUBSEQUENT ADDITIONS THERETO, IN THE RECORDS OF NATRONA COUNTY, WYOMING; DESIGNATING THE TRACT OF LAND AFFECTED BY THIS ACTION AS "TRACT D".

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING:

SECTION 1. -- PORTION OF RIVER DRIVE TO BE VACATED. That that portion of River Drive, lying between the intersections of the said River Drive with Third and Fourth streets, respectively, and extending into and across the said Third street, as such thoroughfares are *feth** shown on the recorded plats of the Town of Mills, The Second Addition to Mills Addition, and The Third Addition to Mills Addition, respectively, recorded under number 79838, on page 572, in the Book of Deeds No. 27, in the records of Natrona county, Wyoming, more particularly described as:

That portion of River Drive enclosed by a boundary line beginning at the most easterly corner of Block 46, within the Town of Mills. Natrona county, Myoming, recorded as hereinbefore described; running themce south 46° 15' east, along the southwest boundary line of Morgan avenue, 160 feet, to the point at which the southwest boundary line of Third street, if extended, intersects the southwest boundary line of Morgan avenue; thence north 60° 10' west, along the southwest boundary line of River Drive, 164.99 feet; thence north 43° 45' east to the point of beginning; the same being a triangular tract of land of 3298 square feet, more or less,

shall be, and the same is hereby vacated and closed forever to use by the town of public Mills, or the residents thereof, as a/thoroughfare; provided that this action does not abridge or destroy any of the rights and priveleges of any resident of the town of Mills, with regard to other streets, alleys, avenues and other thoroughfares within the said town.

SECTION 2.-- DESIGNATION OF TRACT That the portion of River Drive described in Section One of this ordinance, and by the said Section One vacated and closed forever to public use as a thoroughfare, shall hereafter constitute what shall be known as "Tract D" in the NW1 of the SE1 of Section 7, Township 35 North,

Range 79 West of the 6th Principle Meridian, so that "Tract D" will consist of

between the intersection of the said River Drive with Third and Fourth streets, repectively, and extending into and across the said Third street, as the same is shown and designated on the plat of the town of Mills, with additions thereto, recorded as indicated in Section 1 hereof, in the records of Natrona county, Wyoming.

SECTION 3. -- THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BECOME IN FORCE POLLOWING ITS ADOPTION AND ITS BEING POSTED UP FOR A PERIOD OF TEN DAYS, AS REQUIRED BY LAW.
