OBDINANCE NUMBER FIGHTY-SEVENWA

PROVIDING FOR THE AMENDMENT OF ORDINANCE NUMBER FIGHTY-SEVEN.
AS TO THE OFFICIAL NAME OF THE PIPE DEPARTMENT AS USED THEREIN;
AND SECTION TEN SHALL BE AMENDED IN SO PAR AS IT PROHIBITS THE
FIRE DEPARTMENT TO RESPOND TO ALARMS OUTSIDE THE COPPORATE
LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF MILLS; AND SECTION TWENTY (PARAGRAPH
THREE) SHALL INCLUDE THE MILLS VOLUNTEER PIPE DEPARTMENT AS
BEING PREE OF LIABLE TOOFTHER RITH THE TOWN OF MILLS UNDER THE
TERMS THEREOF, AND PROVIDING FOR THE IMMEDIATE EPFECTIVENESS
OF THIS OFDINANCE.

BE IT OFDAINED BY THE WAYOF AND THE COUNCIL OF THE TOEN OF WILLS, WYOKING:

SECTION 1. -- OFFICIAL NAME OF FIFE DEPARTMENT. Be it provided by the terms of this section that each and every time the words "Fire Department" or "Wills Fire Department" shall appear in Ordinance eighty-seven they shall mean the MILLS VOLUNTEEF FIFE DEPARTMENT, and all warrants, vouchers, purchase orders, checks and other printed forms shall also bear the name MILLS VOLUNTEEF FIFE DEPARTMENT.

That section ten of Ordinance Eighty-Seven shall be amended only so far as it refers to "not responding to alarms outside the corporate limits of the Town of Wills. Whereas the members and officers of the WILLS VOLUNTERS FIRE DEPARTMENT did appoint a Committee to ask the Mayor and Town Council to allow them to answer any calls to neighboring communities which they may deem necessary for the public good, therefore this section is enacted in order to grant such permission to the said department.

SECTION 3. -- AMENDING SECTION THEFTY (PARAGRAPH THREE) OF OFDIN-AUGE RIGHTY-SEVEN.

three of Ordinance number eighty-seven shall be amended to read as follows: "And that such officer in charge as aforesaid shall have authority to order demolition of any building whose existance is liable further the spread of any dangerous fire, and the Town of Mills and/or the Mills Volunteer Pire Department shall not be liable for the loss to the owner of such building incurred by reason of such demolition.

ORDINANCE NUMBER EIGHTY-SEVEN-A

SECTION 4 .-- LIMITATION AND EFFECTIVE CLAUSE. That the remainder of Ordinance Number Eighty-seven shall continue in effect, neigher impaired or otherwise affected by the provisions of this amendment; and that this ordinance shall take effect and become in force following its posting for a period of ten days as required by law.
