

ORDINANCE NUMBER EIGHTY-SEVEN-A

PROVIDING FOR THE AMENDMENT OF ORDINANCE NUMBER EIGHTY-SEVEN, AS TO THE OFFICIAL NAME OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT AS USED THEREIN; AND SECTION TEN SHALL BE AMENDED IN SO FAR AS IT PROHIBITS THE FIRE DEPARTMENT TO RESPOND TO ALARMS OUTSIDE THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF MILLS; AND SECTION TWENTY (PARAGRAPH THREE) SHALL INCLUDE THE MILLS VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT AS BEING FREE OF LIABILITY TOGETHER WITH THE TOWN OF MILLS UNDER THE TERMS THEREOF, AND PROVIDING FOR THE IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING:

SECTION 1.--OFFICIAL NAME OF FIRE DEPARTMENT. Be it provided by the terms of this section that each and every time the words "Fire Department" or "Mills Fire Department" shall appear in Ordinance eighty-seven they shall mean the MILLS VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT, and all warrants, vouchers, purchase orders, checks and other printed forms shall also bear the name MILLS VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT.

SECTION 2.--AMENDING SECTION TEN OF ORDINANCE EIGHTY-SEVEN. That section ten of Ordinance Eighty-Seven shall be amended only so far as it refers to "not responding to alarms outside the corporate limits of the Town of Mills. Whereas the members and officers of the MILLS VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT did appoint a Committee to ask the Mayor and Town Council to allow them to answer any calls to neighboring communities which they may deem necessary for the public good, therefore this section is enacted in order to grant such permission to the said department.

SECTION 3.--AMENDING SECTION TWENTY (PARAGRAPH THREE) OF ORDINANCE EIGHTY-SEVEN. That Section twenty, paragraph three of Ordinance number eighty-seven shall be amended to read as follows: "And that such officer in charge as aforesaid shall have authority to order demolition of any building whose existence is liable further the spread of any dangerous fire, and the Town of Mills and/or the Mills Volunteer Fire Department shall not be liable for the loss to the owner of such building incurred by reason of such demolition.

ORDINANCE NUMBER EIGHTY-SEVEN-A

SECTION 4.--LIMITATION AND EFFECTIVE CLAUSE. That the remainder of Ordinance Number Eighty-seven shall continue in effect, neither impaired or otherwise affected by the provisions of this amendment; and that this ordinance shall take effect and become in force following its posting for a period of ten days as required by law.
