

ORDINANCE # 88F

PROVIDING FOR THE ADJUSTMENT OF THE SALARY RATE OF THE WATER COMMISSIONER. REPEALING SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE NUMBER EIGHTY-EIGHT W.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING:

SECTION 1. THAT section 2 of Ordinance # 88E is hereby repealed and that said section will hereafter read as follows;

SECTION 2. SALARY OF WATER COMMISSIONER. The water commissioner of the Town of Mills, Wyoming, shall receive a salary of Three-Thousand, Two-Hundred Thirty (\$3,230.00) dollars per annum, to be paid in eleven monthly payments of Two-Hundred, Sixty-nine dollars and sixteen cents (\$269.16) and one monthly payment of Two-Hundred, Sixty-nine dollars and twenty-four cents. (\$269.24).

SECTION 2. OTHER PORTIONS OF ORDINANCES NOT AFFECTED HEREBY. That nothing herein contained shall be construed as altering or affecting any part of the Ordinance herein amended, except as specifically stated herein with regard to salary.

SECTION 3. THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BECOME IN FORCE UPON ITS ENACTMENT AND BEING POSTED FOR A PERIOD OF TEN DAYS AS REQUIRED BY LAW.
