

ORDINANCE NUMBER EIGHTY-EIGHT G

PROVIDING FOR THE ADJUSTMENT OF THE SALARY RATES OF THE TOWN CLERK-TREASURER AND TOWN MARSHAL. REPEALING SECTION 4 OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 88-E AND SECTIONS 5 and 6 OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 88-E.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING:

SECTION 1. SALARY OF TOWN MARSHAL. That Section 4 of Ordinance Number 88-E is hereby repealed, and that the Town Marshal shall receive a salary of Four-Thousand Five-Hundred (\$4,500) dollars per annum, to be paid in twelve monthly payments of Three-Hundred, Seventy-five (\$375) dollars each.

SECTION 2. SALARY OF TOWN CLERK AND TREASURER. That Sections 5 and 6 of Ordinance Number 88-E is hereby repealed, and that the salary of the combined office of Town Clerk-Treasurer shall be Three-Thousand, Six-Hundred (\$3,600) dollars per annum, payable in twelve monthly payments of Three-Hundred (\$300) dollars each.

SECTION 3. OTHER PORTIONS OF ORDINANCES NOT AFFECTED HEREBY. That nothing herein contained shall be construed as altering or affecting any part of the Ordinances herein amended, except as specifically stated herein with regard to salaries.

SECTION 4. THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BECOME IN FORCE UPON ITS ENACTMENT AND BEING POSTED FOR A PERIOD OF TEN DAYS AS REQUIRED BY LAW.
