

ORDINANCE NUMBER EIGHTY-EIGHT-*

PROVIDING A RATE OF SALARY FOR THE FIRE CHIEF OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING, ADJUSTING THE SALARY RATE OF THE TOWN CLERK AND THE MARSHAL, RESPECTIVELY, OF THE SAID TOWN, AND REPEALING SECTIONS THREE AND FOUR OF ORDINANCE NUMBER EIGHTY-EIGHT, WHICH ORDINANCE ESTABLISHES THE SALARIES OF TOWN OFFICIALS GENERALLY, SAID SECTIONS OF THE SAID ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE SALARY RATES OF THE SAID TOWN CLERK AND MARSHAL, RESPECTIVELY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING:

SECTION 1.-- SALARY OF FIRE CHIEF. That the Chief of the Fire Department of the town of Mills, Wyoming, shall receive a salary of One Hundred Twenty (\$120.00) dollars per annum, to be paid in twelve equal monthly installments of Ten (\$10.00) dollars each; such salary to be irrespective of and in addition to any remuneration received by the said Fire Chief under the provisions of sections Seven and Sixteen of Ordinance Number Eighty-seven.

SECTION 2.-- SALARY OF TOWN CLERK. That the Town Clerk of the ~~town of~~ aforesaid town of Mills shall receive a salary of Four Hundred Twenty (\$420.00) dollars per annum, to be paid in twelve equal monthly installments of Thirty-five (\$35.00) dollars each.

SECTION 3.-- SALARY OF TOWN MARSHAL. That the Marshal of the aforesaid town of Mills shall receive a salary of Six Hundred (\$600.00) dollars per annum, to be paid in twelve equal monthly installments of Fifty (\$50.00) dollars each.

SECTION 4.-- EFFECTIVE WITH BEGINNING OF SUBSEQUENT TERMS OF OFFICE. That the salaries provided in the foregoing sections of this ordinance shall become effective upon the beginning of the official term of those officers succeeding present incumbents in the offices affected by the provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 5.-- SALARIES PAID OUT OF GENERAL FUND That the salaries herein provided shall be paid out of the general fund of the town of Mills, upon proper appropriation of such funds for such purposes, in the same manner as that in which other claims against the town of Mills are paid.

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SECTION 6.-- REPEALING SECTIONS THREE AND FOUR OF ORDINANCE NUMBER EIGHTY-EIGHT. That Sections Three and Four of Ordinance Number Eighty-eight, which ordinance provides and establishes salary rates for several town officials, and which said sections of said ordinance ~~provide~~ establish the salary rates, respectively, of the Town Clerk and the Marshal, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 7.-- EFFECTIVE. That this ordinance shall take effect and become in force as a legal ordinance of the town of Mills, Wyoming, upon its being enacted by the Town Council and posted up for a period of ten days, as required by law.
