PROVIDING FOR THE ADJUSTMENT OF THE SALARY OF THE WATER COMMISSIONER AND OF THE POLICE JUDGE; THE TOWN CLERK AND TREASURER AND THE BUILDING INSPECTOR, RESPECTIVELY, OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING AND REPEALING SECTIONS FIVE AND SIX OF ORDINANCE NUMBER EIGHTY-EIGHT, WHICH ORDINANCE ESTABLISHED THE SALARIES OF TOWN OFFICIALS GENERALLY; AND SECTION TWO OF ORDINANCE EIGHTY-EIGHT-B SALARY OF TOWN CLERK, AND SECTION TWO OF ORDINANCE EIGHTY-EIGHT-B WHICH ESTABLISHES THE SALARY OF TOWN TREASURER; AND SECTION TWO OF ORDINANCE NINETY-THREE, WHICH ESTABLISHES THE SALARY OF BUILDING INSPECTOR.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING:

SECTION 1. SALARY OF WATER COMMISSIONER. That the Water Commissioner of the town of Mills shall receive a salary of Two Thousand five hundred and fifty (\$2,550.00) per annum, to be paid in twelve equal monthly payments of Two Hundred twelve and 50/100 (\$212.50) dollars each.

SECTION 2. SALARY OF POLICE JUDGE. That the Police Judge of the town of Mills shall receive a salary of Three Hundred and sixty (\$360.00) per annum, to be paid in twelve equal monthly installments of Thirty (\$30.00) dollars each.

Section 3. SALARY OF TOWN CLERK. That the Clerk of the town of Mills shall reveive a salary of Seven Hundred eighty (\$780.00) per annum to be paid in twelve equal monthly installments of Sixty-five (\$65.00) dollars each.

SECTION 4. SALARY OF TREASURER. That the Treasurer of the town of Mills shall receive a salary of Seven Hundged twenty (\$720.00) per annum to be paid in twelve equal monthly installments of Sixty (60.00) dollars each.

SECTION 5. SALARY OF BUILDING INSPECTOR. That the Building Inspector of the town of Mills shall receive a salary of One Mundred twenty (\$120.00) dollars per annum, to be paid in twelve equal monthly installments of Ten (\$10.00) dollars each.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE WITH BEGINNING OF SUBSEQUENT TERMS OF OFFICE. That the salaries provided in the foregoing sections of this ordinance shall be effective upon the beginning of the official term of all those officers succeeding present incumbents in the offices affected by the provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 7. That the salaries of officials of the town of Mills herein provided shall be paid out of the general fund of the said town, upon proper appropriation of such funds for such purposes, in the same manner as that in which other claims afainst the town of Mills are paid.

SECTION 8. REPEAL OF ALL SECTIONS AND SUB-SECTIONS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

That Sections five and six of Ordinance Number Eighty-eight,
Section two of Ordinance Number Eighty-eight-A, Section two of Ordinance Number Eighty-eight B and section two of Ordinance Number Ninety
three are hereby amended, insofar as the above named sections relate
to the salaries of any of the above named officials, which salaries
shall be as herein established, notwithstanding the provision of any
of the sections herein amended; and all other ordinances and parts of
ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 9. OTHER PORTIONS OF ORDINANCES NOT AFFECTED HEREBY. That nothing herein contained shall be construed as altering or affecting any part of the Ordinances herein amended, except as specifically stated herein with regard to salaries.

SECTION 10. THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BECOME IN FORCE UPON ITS ENACTMENT AND BEING POSTED FOR A PERIOD OF TEN DAYS AS REQUIRED BY LAW.
