

ORDINANCE NUMBER EIGHTY-EIGHT-D

PROVIDING FOR THE ADJUSTMENT OF THE SALARY OF THE STREET COMMISSIONER AND THE POLICE JUDGE AND THE TOWN TREASURER, RESPECTIVELY, OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING, REPEALING SECTION SEVEN OF ORDINANCE EIGHTY-EIGHT, AND SECTIONS TWO AND FOUR OF ORDINANCE EIGHTY-EIGHT-C, OF SAID SECTIONS OF ORDINANCES NOT APPLICABLE HEREBY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING:

SECTION 1. SALARY OF STREET COMMISSIONER. That Section seven of Ordinance Number eighty-eight is hereby repealed, and that the Street Commissioner of the town of Mills shall receive a salary of One Thousand and fifty (\$1,050.00) dollars per annum, to be paid in twelve equal monthly payments of Eighty-seven (\$87.50) dollars and Fifty cents each.

SECTION 2. That Section Two (2) of Ordinance eighty-eight-C, which establishes a salary rate for the Police Judge of the Town of Mills is hereby repealed; and that the salary of the said official shall be Six Hundred and no/100 (\$600.00) dollars per annum, to be paid in twelve equal monthly installments of Fifty (\$50.00) dollars each.

SECTION 3. That Section Four (4) of Ordinance eighty-eight-C, which establishes a salary rate for the Town Treasurer of the Town of Mills is hereby repealed; and that the salary of the Town Treasurer shall be One Thousand and twenty (\$1,020.00) dollars per annum, to be paid in twelve equal monthly payments of Eighty-five (\$85.00) dollars each.

SECTION 4. OTHER PORTIONS OF ORDINANCES NOT APPLICABLE HEREBY. That nothing herein contained shall be construed as altering or affecting any part of the Ordinances herein amended, except as specifically stated herein with regard to salaries.

SECTION 5. THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BECOME IN FORCE UPON ITS ENACTMENT AND BEING POSTED FOR A PERIOD OF TEN DAYS AS REQUIRED BY LAW.
