THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE FOR THE NEW FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING MARCH 1, 1951 and ENDING FEBRUARY 28, 1952

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING:

SECTION 1.--UNEXPENDED MONEYS TO REVERT TO GENERAL FUND. That all moneys hereby appropriated, but remaining unexpended at the end of the fiscal year for which this appropriation is made, shall revert to the general fund of the Town and shall be subject to subsequent a ppropriation.

SECTION 2.--STATED ESTIMATE OF AVAILABLE ASSETS. That the present and anticipated assets of the town of Mills, from which the herein provided appropriated moneys are to be disbursed during the course of the fiscal year, are hereby stated to be approximately as follows:

Present bank balance, less outstanding checks \$ 950.00

Uncollected Tax revenue for the year 1950 ... 725.00

Estimated tax income for the year 1951 ... 2,500.00

Estimated water rental income for 1951 ... 9,350.00

Liquor Licenses ... 1,650.00

Estimated gasoline tax income for 1951 ... 900.00

Estimated income from sewer service for 1951 ... 2,000.00

SECTION 3.--APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS. That there is hereby appropriated from the general fund of the town of Mills, for the purpose of defraying the municipal expense of the said town, during the fiscal year beginning March 1, 1951, and ending February 28, 1952, the following sums for the following purposes, to wit:
