**A RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING RECOGNITION OF
BETABELEROS DAY FOR 2023**

WHEREAS, The University of Wyoming's American Heritage Center is honoring on this day Betabeleros, Mexican and Mexican American sugar beet laborers whose contribution to the agricultural industry in Wyoming was vital and significant; and


WHEREAS, Mexican American agricultural workers have had a presence in Wyoming since the 1840s, in the cattle and sheep industries since the late 19th Century, and in the Sugar Beet industry in Wyoming since the early 20th Century; and

WHEREAS, The Wyoming Betabeleros' News: La Pagina Espanol of The Powell Tribune (1927)" has been the topic of research from Professor Conxita Domenech and Assistant Professor Chelsea Escalante, both in UW's Department of Modern and Classical Languages who are presenting their discussion on the topic today, which shall also feature a video appearance by Raymond Silva, of Torrington, the son of Wyoming betabeleros, one of Wyoming's first Wyoming Mexican American educators and one of the last living Wyoming residents able to give a firsthand account of this time in the state's beet labor history, and

WHEREAS, The community descended from the Betabeleros has been a significant Wyoming community and contributor to the State and Region, including the City of Mills, the Silva family being amongst those who are related to the current Mayor of the City.

NOW THEREFORE, The City of Mills, Wyoming hereby proclaims this to be Betabeleros Day in the City of Mills, Wyoming for 2023.


