

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-35

RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE ENACTMENT OF S. 1455 THE
UNIQUE ZIP CODE ACT, TO ESTABLISH A SINGLE ZIP CODE FOR
THE COMMUNITY OF MILLS

WHEREAS, The City of Mills currently has a unique Zip Code that is of very limited application, while most of the City bears a common Zip Code with the City of Casper, Wyoming; and

WHEREAS, The lack of a unique Zip Code for Mills creates numerous problems for the City of Mills, including entities subject to franchise agreements not realizing that they are in Mills, rather than Casper, and businesses being confused as to their proper municipal identification; and

WHEREAS, The City of Mills has worked for years too attempt to have a unique Zip Code assigned to the City of Mills; and

WHEREAS, As a practical matter, it takes an Act of Congress for the unique Zip Code to be assigned; and

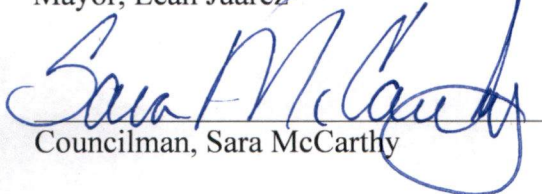
WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1455, The Unique Zip Code Act, would assign a unique Zip Code to the City of Mills.
