

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF MILLS FIRE DEPARTMENT TO PROVIDE MEDICAL OXYGEN BOTTLES ON EMERGENCY BASIS

WHEREAS, Power outages can create situations in which those who rely on home oxygen supply are unable to use their equipment to recharge their oxygen; and

WHEREAS, Central and Northeastern Wyoming recently experienced such an event; and

WHEREAS, Those dependent upon a supply of oxygen can be subject to a medical emergency if they are not able to have oxygen available; and

WHEREAS, Such emergencies ultimately create the need to transport the person who depends upon oxygen to the hospital; and

WHEREAS, The City of Mills Fire Department has a limited supply of oxygen bottles suitable for home use which are not dedicated to ambulance service; and

WHEREAS, It would serve the interest of the City of Mills and the residents of the City of Mills to make said oxygen bottles available to residents who depend upon oxygen in such circumstances so that they do not need to be transported to the hospital

NOW, THEREFORE, The City of Mills, Wyoming, hereby authorizes the City of Mills Fire Department to provide oxygen bottles to residents of the City of Mills who have prescriptions for medical oxygen, on a temporary basis, when power outages create emergencies for people dependent upon medical oxygen, providing however, that all Recipients shall sign an agreement memorializing the provision of oxygen tanks and exculpating the City of Mills and its employees of all liability associated with the provision of the same.


