REGULAR TOWN HALL MEETING

September 28th, 2016

Meeting called to order by Mayor at 7:00pm

Present: Mayor Coleman, Councilman McCarthy, Councilman Pitts.

Pledge of Allegiance:

<u>Approval of the Minutes from September 14th, 2016:</u> Councilman Pitts made the motion to approve the minutes from September 14th, 2016. Councilman McCarthy seconded. All Ayes-Motion carried.

<u>Mayor to Appoint Christine Trumbull as Town Clerk</u>: Mayor Coleman announced the appointment of Christine Trumbull as Town Clerk. Councilman McCarthy made the motion to approve the appointment of Christine Trumbull as Town Clerk. Councilman Pitts seconded. All Ayes-Motion carried. Mayor read her oath to position of Town Clerk.

Business Licenses:

All businesses are out of town and not required to come. Councilman Pitts made the motion to approve all the new businesses listed above. Councilman McCarthy seconded. All Ayes-Motion carried.

<u>Resolution 2016-26</u>: Authorizing the Interim Mayor to Execute Agreement with Children's Advocacy Project and Providing for the Payment of Services Provided. Councilman Pitts made the motion to approve Resolution 2016-26. Councilman McCarthy seconded. All Ayes-Motion carried.

<u>Resolution 2016-27</u>: Approving the Building Inspector will have a Town Credit Card to Use for Work Expenses. Councilman McCarthy made the motion to approve Resolution 2016-27. Councilman Pitts seconded. All Ayes-Motion carried.

Resolution 2016-28: A Resolution Authorizing the Mayor and Council Members the Option to Participate in the Cell Phone Agreement. Councilman Pitts made the motion to approve Resolution 2016-28. Councilman McCarthy seconded. All Ayes-Motion carried.

Resolution 2016-29: A Resolution Approving the Vacation and Replat of ByPass Industrial Park NO. 2. Kevin O'Hearn mentioned that we are doing this because it is 1 mile from our growth boundary. Councilman McCarthy made the motion to approve Resolution 2016-29. Councilman Pitts seconded. All Ayes-Motion carried.

<u>Resolution 2016-30</u>: A Resolution Designating that the Clerk of Court Be Added as a Signor on the Court Accounts. Councilman Pitts made the motion to approve Resolution 2016-30. Councilman McCarthy seconded. All Ayes-Motion carried.

Resolution 2016-31: Salaries. Mayor mentioned that there were some administration errors on the first one that needed to be fixed and cleared up. Councilman Pitts made the motion to approve Resolution 2016-31. Councilman McCarthy seconded. All Ayes-Motion carried.

Ordinance 685: 3rd AND FINAL READING: An Ordinance Amending Ordinance 624; To Establish Permit Fees for Building Additions, Mechanical & Plumbing, Gas Appliances, Demolition of Residential & Commercial Buildings, Fences, Porches, Decks, Roofing, Landscaping and Signs, with changes. Councilman McCarthy made the motion to approve Ordinance 685 on 3rd final reading. Councilman Pitts seconded. All Ayes-Motion carried. Robert Selvery asked that if a person is doing some minor repairs do they have to have a permit. Kevin mentioned that for minor repairs no but we follow the Residential Codes of 2015.

Ordinance 686: 3rd AND FINAL READING: (Tabled 9-14-2016) An Ordinance Amending Ordinance 647 Mobile Homes: Councilman Pitts made the motion to take Ordinance 686 off the table. Councilman McCarthy seconded. All Ayes-Motion carried. Councilman Pitts made the motion to approve Ordinance 686 on 3rd and final reading with changes to the appeals section that was read by the Mayor. Councilman McCarthy seconded. All Ayes-Motion carried.

<u>Ordinance 687: 3rd AND FINAL READING</u>: An Ordinance to Amend the Mills Municipal Code 5-12-220 Article VI; Special Permits: Councilman Pitts made the motion to bring Ordinance 687 off the table. Councilman McCarthy seconded. All Ayes-Motion carried. Councilman McCarthy made the motion to approve Ordinance 687 on 2nd reading with changes. Councilman Pitts seconded. All Ayes-Motion carried.

<u>Ordinance 691:</u> 1st Reading: An Ordinance Establishing an amendment to the Annual Appropriation of Funds for The Fiscal Year 2015-2016. For the Town of Mills, Natrona County, Wyoming. No motion was established therefore it died.

<u>Ordinance 692: 1st Reading:</u> An Ordinance Amending Ordinance 642 of the Town of Mills; Pertaining to the Hours of Service and Compensation for the Office of Mayor. Councilman Pitts made the motion to approve Ordinance 692 on 1st reading. Councilman McCarthy seconded. All Ayes-Motion carried.

Ordinance 693: 1st Reading: An Ordinance to Amend Section 2.24.090 of the Mills Municipal Code to Specify a Date Certain for the Municipal Court to Settle Its Accounts and Make Payment to the Town Treasurer. Councilman McCarthy made the motion to approve Ordinance 693 on 1st reading. Councilman Pitts seconded. All Ayes-Motion carried.
